

At Brandesburton Primary School we feel that we are in a strong position if funding ends. Firstly the training and CPD opportunities the staff have had has helped extend PE knowledge. Teachers have observed, planned, team taught and delivered alongside external agencies, coaches and the PE lead to improve the areas they highlighted in their CPD. When reviewed teachers felt they felt more comfortable in approaching and delivering high quality PE lessons that are fun, engaging and inspiring across all areas of PE.

In addition we have managed to establish links with local sporting communities and clubs. We have a strong link with the Hainsworth Park Golf Club where an after school club is run in the summer term which is well attended. Also to keep this link going in the future we have purchased golf equipment and added golf to the curriculum to further enhance the link. Another link has been made we the bowls and tennis club and during our Sport Week we go to each club and participate in coaching and fun sessions led by the clubs representatives; the bowls club has also now purchased 3 sets of junior bowls so we aim to promote this link even further in the future.

The money has also helped enhance and outdoor areas and sporting equipment so that lessons and free time can be interactive with the children being inspired to try out a range of different sports that challenge and promote all pupils. Finally we are hoping in the summer to purchase ICT equipment that can be solely used for PE. This will help children analyse performance, tactics and improve technique - while also helping to broaden the use of PE through the curriculum.
