After the great success of last year's Brandesburton Art Prize we are pleased to announce the launch of the 2018/19 competition. We have taken account of the feedback received from both adults and children and we have decided to introduce a theme and artistic medium for this year's competition.

We would be delighted to receive photos (taken by the children) based on the theme of design and engineering. We are looking for examples of engineering in action such as wind turbines or amazing feats of engineering such as the Humber Bridge. The photos can be taken using any device that has a camera (no need to go out and purchase an expensive DSLR!). There is not a set manner in which the photos should be presented, however when submitting your entry, it must be clear as to who took the photo and which class you are in. Please note electronic copies cannot be submitted, they must be printed.

The entries will be judge in the following categories:

- Foundation Stage
- Key Stage 1
- Key Stage 2
- Overall Winner (to be selected from the winners of the above categories).

The winner of each category will receive a prize and the overall winner will have their name engraved onto the Art Prize plaque, which will be loaned to the winner for two weeks.

The closing date for all entries is **Friday 1st March**, photos submitted after this date will not be entered into the competition. Last year, adults in school took part in a separate competition and this year we invite parents and carers to participate; so if you are a budding David Bailey, feel free to submit an entry.
