On Tuesday, we continued sharing our learning with parents and carers. KS1 (class one and two), opened their doors to share the wonderful maths which takes place. A big thank you to Mr Mallison and Mrs Platten for organising this.

If you would like to support your child with maths at home, we have Times Table RockStars set up for every child and we also would like to recommend 'White Rose Hub' App, it's a 1-minute maths app which helps children build greater number confidence and fluency.

Foundation Stage

FS1 were incredibly proud to show how well they know the numbers 0 - 10. They can say and count to ten. The whole team are working hard to explore the value of each number and not rush the fundamental elements of maths.

Why are numbers so important?

Children need to develop a positive attitude to maths and not be afraid to make a mistake.

Children need our help to explore, experiment and discover. Repeating maths activities will develop understanding of mathematical concepts. Children will begin to understand regular daily routines, like snack time and going-home time, and how to use numbers to describe things.

We must encourage children to use numbers 'in context', using numbers in practice, not just in theory. This deepens their understanding. Children can then apply their knowledge and experiment. They can test their new understanding of maths by using numbers in context through the day in real-life situations.
