When you arrive at school you will walk through these gates and onto the Foundation Stage playground. You will also line up here at the end of the morning and your parents will be waiting for you on the main path.

Some days you might do a little game or activity with Miss McIntyre, Mrs Gardner or Mrs Laughton and some of your friends.

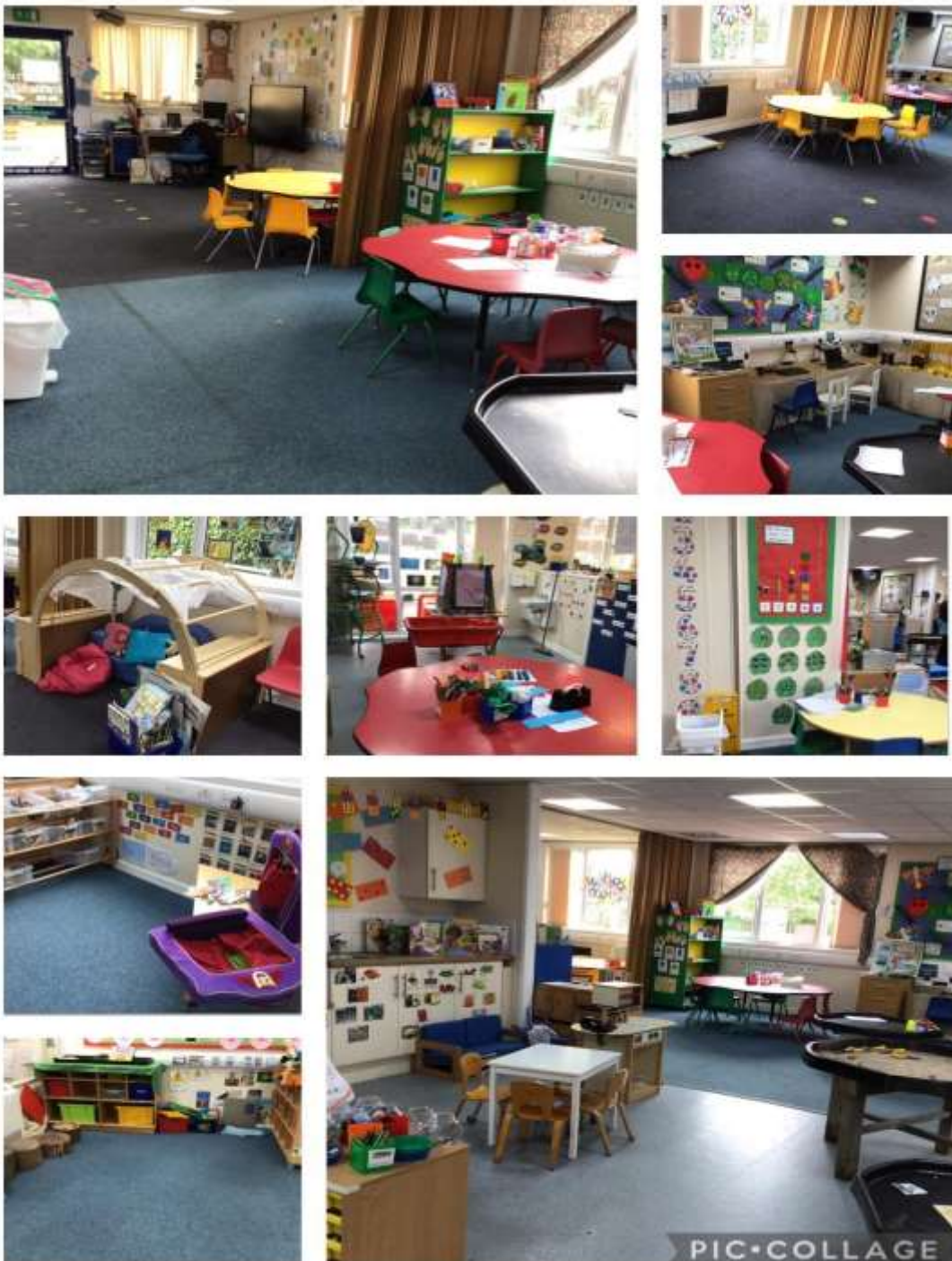
