White Rose Maths



We will be basing our Maths teaching around the White Rose Maths scheme.

Blocks of learning will include:

- Ratio
- Decimals
- Fractions Decimals and Percentages
- Converting units

In addition to this, children will develop their arithmetic skills through 'Quick Starts' and "Mental Arithmetic Friday" as well as learn how to tackle exam type questions.

English

Reading and Writing



In guided reading, we will be continuing to read Pig heart Boy.

Writing outcomes will include:

- Newspaper Report
- Instructions
- Myth
- Explanation Texts

We will also exploit writing opportunities across the curriculum.

In addition to this, children will learn spelling rules.

Design Technology

Jewellery

Children will investigate Ancient Egyptian Jewellery and how this was made. They will discover this by using a variety of tools and techniques through evaluating items from the past. They will then have the chance to design, make and evaluate their own product.

Science

Light and Sound

Children will learn about how light and sound travel in the world. They will look at reflection and refraction before conducting experiments about shadows. During these children will develop their prediction, fair test and conclusion skills while also having to think carefully about different variables. Children will also learn about how a sound is made. They will explore vibration and pitch of a sound again conducting experiments to improve their scientific skills.

Physical Education

Basketball/Gym/Tag Rugby/Dance



Children will apply and develop a broader range of skills, learning how to use them in different ways and to link them to make improve their actions and movements. They will develop their communication and collaboration skills by competing with each other and increase their understanding of how to improve in different physical activities and sports. They will learn how to evaluate their own skills and the effect exercise has upon the body.

Computing

Animation

Children will learn about how to create stop motion animations. They will explore using simple animations, how to use animation frames and how to add features to their own that they create. Finally, they will critically analyse on their own and their peers work offering advice on how they can improve.

History

Egypt



Children learn about the Egyptian Civilisation and culture. They will start by looking at where the Egyptians fit in a chronological timeline comparing with other periods. Children will also learn about the life, society and civilisation of ancient Egyptians and will also use sources of evidence to be able to analyse how effective the civilisation was.

Art & Design

Hieroglyphic Masks



Children will learn Egyptian Mask exploring how and why they were used. They will use different techniques to develop their drawing and sketching skills with different media. They will explore the positioning of images to create the most effective compositions as well as perspective and depth. They will evaluate their own pictures and make comparisons with the techniques used by a variety of artists.

Geography

River Nile



Children will learn the location of the River Nile and the country of Egypt. They will find out more about both the physical and human geography of the continent. This will include looking at the climate and how important the Nile was to the Ancient Egyptians. They will finish off the unit by researching and presenting an information text based on this.
