# <u>Homework</u>

For year 5 there will be homework set most weeks. The homework will be written in children's reading log or will be on our Class 4 blog. This will be stated in the reading logs/blog when the homework is expected to be back in school.

# <u>Spellings</u>

As a school we promote the purple mash spelling program. Your child will be given spellings every Monday. We will then do a spelling test on the Friday for the children to complete. You will be able to access the children's spellings via purple mash.
