As writers...

After this, will be a persuasive piece of writing trying to persuade people to live in Brandesburton/Hull.

As mathematicians...

Year 5 – In the autumn term our focus will be on:

Place value – numbers up to 1,000,000 Addition and subtraction with numbers more than 4 digits

Multiplication and division – multiplying and dividing by 10,100,1000

Fractions – adding and subtracting fractions

In Physical education year 5 this term we will be focusing on Football and handball.

Trips and Other activities

We will be visiting Stepney Primary school later on this year to explore the differences in our communities and to collect data on both areas

As artists...

Year 5 be taking inspiration from Ian Mitchell, this is an artist who focuses on perspective. Our art work will be influenced and linked to our geographical study of the local area. We will be focussing on drawing and painting landscapes.



As scientists...

In Science this term our focus is Properties and changes of materials. In this unit we will cover the use of evaporation to recover solutes. We will explain reversible and irreversible changes, chemical reactions, burning reactions and reactions that include different acids mixed with bicarbonate of soda.

As designers...
