Alesha, Izzy and Isabelle all passed their very first ballet exam .



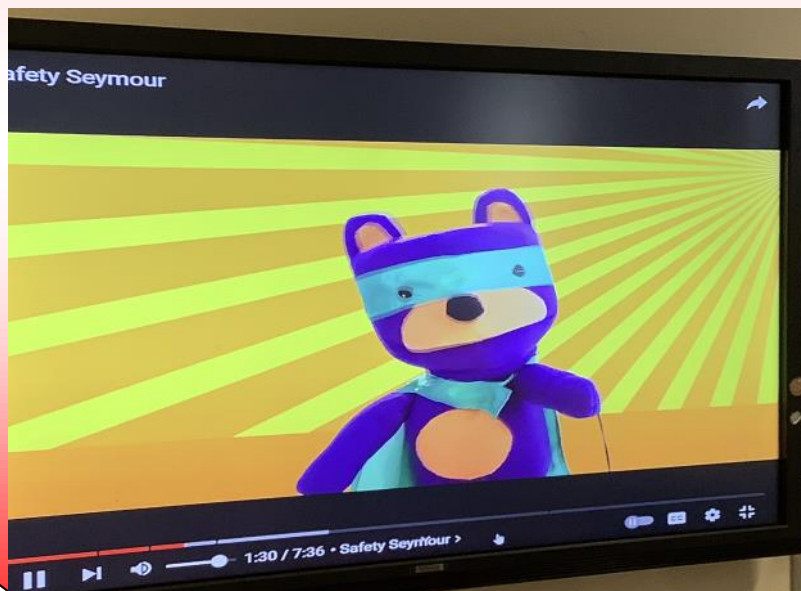

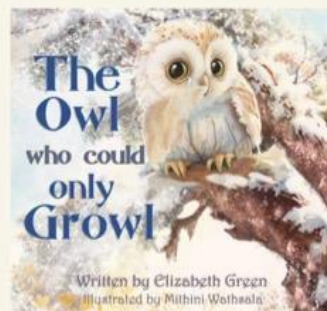
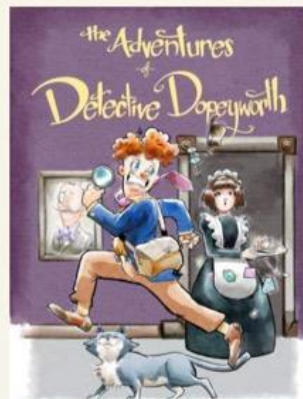
