

Guidance for parents:

Key Stage One: Class 2

Areas:

Home Work	Class 2 homework is posted weekly on the blog. It covers the weekly spelling pattern plus a task from another curriculum subject and reading.
PE	Children come to school in their PE kit twice a week on certain planned days. PE kit consists of: Winter – Outdoor - Black track suit bottoms, leggings or joggers. Trainers and in some cases a change of shoes. White t-shirt and black hoodie or school jumper. Indoor - Black shorts and white t-shirt. Trainers. Summer – Black shorts and white t-shirt. Trainers.
Lunches	12.10pm – 1.10 pm. All children are eligible for a free school meal.
Trips (payment/organisation)	Voluntary contributions will be requested and can be paid on our online system Parentpay
Blog – where/ when	Class 2 blog can be found at https://class2-blog.brandesburton.eastriding.sch.uk/ A blog is posted weekly for homework and celebration of the week (plus STEM blog is posted weekly)
Clubs	These are offered by letter sent out when they are available. Children can then sign up if they wish.
Parent evenings	Take place in the autumn and summer terms.
Reports	Parents/carers receive a yearly report around June/July of each year
How to communicate concerns	Initial concerns regarding the education of your child should be communicated through your child's teacher as they may be best placed to address this concern and provide reassurance and put in place any agreed actions. Please arrange this through the school office. If this does not resolve the issue, please contact the school office to make an appointment to see Miss Northen.
