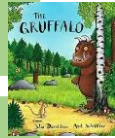


As writers...

They will be writing a 3 part story retelling a journey and a non-chronological report using, 'The Pirates Next Door' as their stimulus. Additionally, they will write an adventure story and a diary using, 'The Gruffalo' as a stimulus.

They will be focusing on improving their sentence structures, adding capital letters and full stops and letter formation.

Moreover, they will be developing understanding of suffixes, prefixes and exclamation marks.



Year 1 Curriculum Map Autumn Term 2023

As historians...

Year 1 will be focusing on the key conceptual idea of 'Similarity and Difference' by comparing seaside holidays of present, to those from the past. They will specifically be focusing on travel, entertainment and dress during the Victorian, and post-war eras and comparing them with what they know of seaside holidays today.

As geographers...

This term, Year 1 will be completing a comparative study of Brandesburton and a local seaside village/town, e.g. Bridlington. They will be building upon their prior knowledge of their village and its locality, looking at the similarities and differences of human and physical features and focusing on developing their map and fieldwork skills.

As ICT experts...

This term, Year 1 will be working on their digital literacy skills. Moreover, we will learn about algorithms, instructions and coding.

As readers...

Year 1 will be continuing to develop their phonics knowledge by working at the appropriate levels of the Read Write Inc phonics scheme. There will be daily story time and weekly 'Stay and Read' sessions.

As mathematicians...

Year 1 - Will be focusing on place value within 20 and 50, addition within 20, length and height and mass and volume.

The children will develop fluency skills initially, followed by reasoning and problem solving.

As PE experts...

In PE the children will be developing their running, jumping, throwing and catching skills whilst also developing their balance, agility and co-ordination. We will focus on Dodgeball, Dance, Orienteering and Net ball to learn these skills.

Trips and Other activities

This term the children will be looking at seaside holidays, in history. We would be grateful if you have any family photographs at the seaside (home or abroad), that you would like to share with us!

Jigsaw

This half term, our unit is called 'Dreams and Goals.'

The children will explore aspirations, how to achieve goals and understanding the emotions that go with this.

Next half-term our unit is called, 'Healthy Me.' They will learn all about being and keeping safe and healthy.

As scientists...

This term Year 1 will be learning about seasonal change and Everyday Materials. They will continue to make observations of how seasons change. Additionally, they will investigate how materials can be used and how suitable they are for different jobs.

As designers...

Our design and technology unit in Key Stage 1, this term, focuses on textiles. The children will be taking inspiration from Punch and Judy puppets of the past to create their own hand puppets. They will be learning how to complete a simple running stitch to join materials.

As artists...

Year 1 will be taking inspiration from their history and geography units to create a collage based on the seaside. They will be investigating the work of well known artists, Megan Coyle and John Piper, and taking inspiration from images of the local East Coast. They will explore using materials to create different textures as well as investigate different collage techniques.
