Clothing

Sun cream

Weather permitting, we will doing PE lessons outside this term. Please could your child wear trainers in school as part of their PE kit. PE lessons will continue to be on a Thursday. FS2 children can come to school in their PE kit. FS1 children do not require a PE kit.
