## Please don't cause an obstruction

<u>Is it illegal to park on zig-zag lines outside schools?</u>


Yes, it's always illegal to park on yellow zig-zag lines anywhere.

Rule 243 of the Highway Code indicates a range of places where motorists must not park.

It also states that drivers must not park near a school entrance, anywhere that would prevent access for emergency services.

Parking outside a school specifically may obstruct visibility for parents and children trying to cross the road and is thus highly dangerous.
