As writers...

In year 3 and 4 this term, we will be exploring the resolutions and endings of stories and using this knowledge to write our own. We will then move onto look at letter writing and write letters to explain events. We will also be looking at fantasy stories linking to our work on Vikings. Finally we will complete a poetry unit. We will be consolidating all our spelling, grammar and punctuation work.

As mathematicians...

Year 3 – Will be completing work on fractions, mass, capacity, money, time, shape and statistics.

Year 4 – Will be completing work on fractions, decimals, money, time, shape, statistics, position and direction.

All year 4 children will also complete the Multiplication Check – The learning and practicing of times tables is so important.

As historians...

Year 3 and 4 will be looking at Anglo-Saxons and Vikings, exploring the key question, 'What are the causes and consequences of the Anglo-Saxon and Viking invasion and settlement in Britain?' We will explore timelines and sources of evidence to build up a picture of life during the time.

As scientists...

Year 3 will focus their work around Plants and Animals and Humans.

Year 4 will firstly look at Animals including Humans and then move onto explore Sound.

Through both year groups and topics the children will continue to build up their investigation skills such as fair testing, observing and analysising.

As ICT experts...

Year 3 will be exploring branching databases, graphing and simulations. Year 4 will be exploring how to write for different audiences and investigating hardware. After this, both year groups will explore spreadsheets.
