

Year 2 – Will be writing a character description using ‘Here come the aliens!’ as their stimulus. They will then be writing a setting description based on a setting from the short animated film ‘taking Flight’. There will be the opportunity to read some Bonfire Night poetry and to create their own original bonfire poems.

The children will be focusing on improving their sentence structures, adding capital letters and full stops and letter formation.



As historians...

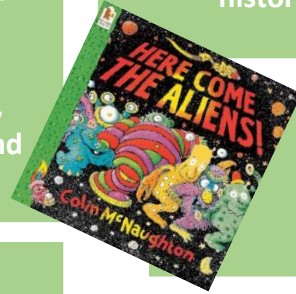
KS1 will be focusing on the key conceptual idea of ‘Significance’ by investigating Amy Johnson and considering why she was a significant figure. They will also be studying local history and the city of Hull.

As geographers...

This term, KS1 will be focusing on a comparative study of Brandesburton and Hull. They will use their local knowledge of Brandesburton to make comparisons between features of both locations. They will use aerial photos to recognise landmarks and physical features in terms of buildings

As ICT experts...

This term, year 2 will be working on their digital literacy skills . They will consolidate their learning on staying safe online. They will learn to share work and communicate electronically . They will be using search engines to find information.

As readers...

Year 2 will be continuing to develop their phonics knowledge by working at the appropriate levels of the Read Write Inc phonics scheme. Once they have completed the programme, they will be moving onto whole class guided reading lessons, this term the focus text being ‘The Owl Who Was Afraid of the Dark’.

As mathematicians...

Year 2 - Will be focusing on counting, writing, ordering and partitioning numbers to 100. They will then add and subtract across 10 and two 2-digit numbers. Finally they will be investigating the properties of 2D and 3D shapes.

As PE experts...

In outdoor PE the children will develop their spatial awareness whilst throwing, catching, hitting and kicking different balls. They will participate in team games, learn to use tactics and play by the rules.

Trips and Other Activities

We are hoping to arrange a visit to Hull, including a visit to Ferens Art gallery, in conjunction with our art curriculum and history curriculum.

As artists...

KS1 will be making observational drawing of objects and artefacts from the local area including detailed drawing of leaves, trees and flowers. Pupils will study modern art from the Art Nouveau period through to the latter 1900’s.

As scientists...

This term year 2 will be learning about living things and their habitats. We will pose and discuss the question, ‘how do we know we are alive?’ The children will be working scientifically to develop their disciplinary skills of sorting, grouping and classifying .

As designers...

Our KS1 design and technology unit this term, focuses on Mechanisms and Structures. The children will be designing & building a toy plane with a chassis, wheel and axle mechanism. This is linked to our history work on Amy Johnson and flight.

Jigsaw...

This term, our units are ‘Being me in my world’ and ‘Celebrating Difference’. We will discuss ‘who am I and how do I fit?’ We will talk about our hopes and fears and understand about our rights and responsibilities in the world. We will also be looking at similarities and differences.

Religion and Worldviews...

Year 2 will be learning more about Belonging and Christmas. (Islam, Christianity, Humanism)
