We are trying our hardest to improve reading fluency and arithmetic skills whole school.

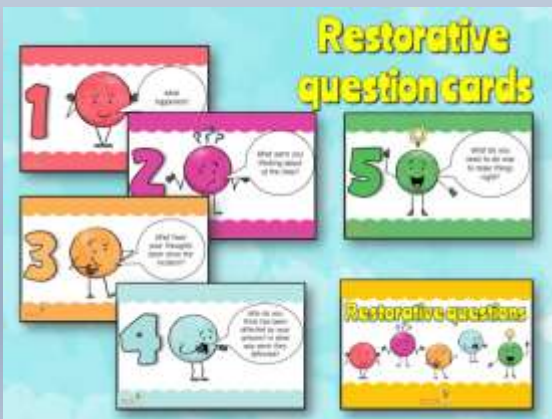
If you could support this at home with home reading and TT Rockstars, it would be very much appreciated.

## Can you help us?

Last year we had some children who urgently needed our help. They had no Christmas coming and the families were in absolute crisis (there was more than one). The team of staff here at Brandesburton were amazing and we rallied round to buy things ourselves and provide lots and lots of items including weekly food parcels. We found an amazing charity in Hull called Santa Squad. We reached out and the children wrote Christmas wish lists to Santa and they made this happen - all wrapped and labelled.

This year I received an email asking if I had any children needing this service. As a school we would like to help support the charity and the amazing work they do.



A bit more information:

Santa Squad is a group of 10-11yr olds who decided they wanted to help children and families in need across Hull and Surrounding Areas who wouldn't be getting anything for Christmas.

They started their Big Christmas Collection 2 years ago and have helped hundreds of children and families so far.

Each year they work with schools and organisations to reach those most in need. They gather donations of new toys, clothes, toiletries, and food and each referral will get a Santa Sack full of items to meet their needs.

Items we are asking for;

Toys: babies - teens

Books: babies - adults

Games: babies - adults

Sensory Equipment: babies - adults

Clothes: babies - adults (pjs, dressing gowns, etc are usually a big ask. Something warm)

Toiletries: babies - adults

Food: tinned foods, dry items such as rice, pasta, cereals, jars, tea bags, coffee, packets, selection boxes, treats etc.

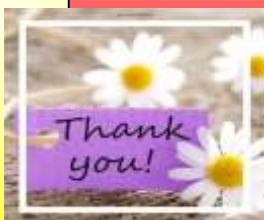
On the last weeks of the school year staff were given so many incredibly kind and thoughtful gifts and cards.
