

As writers...

Year 2 – Will be writing a character description using 'The Three Little Pigs' story as their stimulus. They will then be writing a setting description.

They will be continuing to focus on developing writing fluency, as well as improving their sentence structures and engaging the reader, by adding simple description.



As historians...

KS1 will be focusing on the key conceptual idea of 'Cause and Consequence' by investigating; What were the causes and consequences of the Great Fire of London?

As geographers...

This term, KS1 will be focusing on a comparative study of the capital cities in the United Kingdom and investigating the characteristics of the land. They will use recent and historic maps to compare and also use directional knowledge (N,E,S,W) linked to the Great Fire of London and the direction of the fire.

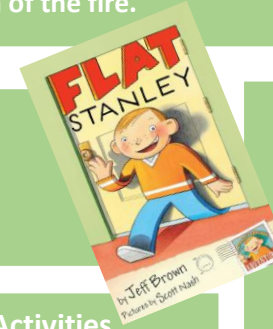
As ICT Experts...

Year 2 will be using 2Paint a Picture to recreate different styles of art including impressionism and pointillism and also the work of artists Piet Mondrian and William Morris. They will also be using the 2Sequence program to make music and 2code to learn about coding.

KS1 Curriculum Map Spring Term 2025

As readers...

Year 2 will be continuing to develop their phonics knowledge by working at the appropriate levels of the Read Write Inc phonics scheme. Once they have completed the programme, they will be moving onto whole class guided reading lessons, this term the focus text being 'Flat Stanley'.



As mathematicians...

Year 2 will begin by making the connection between repeated addition and multiplication. They will explore both equal and unequal groups and develop language around repeated addition. Children will then use this knowledge to complete multiplication calculations as repeated addition.

As sports people...

In PE this term, the children will be focusing on Dance and Football. The children will be learning to move confidently and safely and develop fundamental movement skills, linking different ways of travelling to music, with control.

In Football, children will improve their ability to move fluently changing speed and direction, both with and without a ball.

Trips and Other Activities

We are hoping to arrange a further trip to Wassand Hall as the school enjoyed these visits enormously last year. We will also be celebrating British Science Week in March.

Jigsaw

This term, our units are 'Dreams and Goals' and 'Healthy Me'. We will discuss aspirations, how to achieve goals and understanding the emotions that go with this. We will also look at being and keeping safe and healthy.

As artists...

KS1 will be using the Great Fire of London as a stimulus for investigating colour mixing, mood and gradient. Pupils will study modern art from the Baroque period – early 17th century through to the 1750's.

As scientists...

This term Year 2 will be learning about everyday uses of materials. They will investigate how some materials can be used for more than one thing and some materials are not suitable for certain purposes.

As designers...

Our KS1 design and technology unit this term, focuses on food and nutrition. The children will learn about making dough and baking bread. This will compliment their study of the Great Fire of London although hopefully they won't burn their bread!
